


iBoy by Kevin Brooks

Frontal Lobe	Location	Characteristics
	The frontal lobe is found in the area around your forehead.	It is concerned with emotions, reasoning, planning, movement, and parts of speech. It is also involved in purposeful acts such as creativity, judgment, problem solving, and planning.
Parietal Lobe	Location	Characteristics
	The parietal lobes are found behind the frontal lobes, above the temporal lobes, and at the top back of the brain.	They are connected with the processing of nerve impulses related to the senses, such as touch, pain, taste, pressure, and temperature. They also have language functions.
Temporal Lobe	Location	Characteristics
	The temporal lobes are found on either side of the brain and just above the ears.	Responsible for hearing, memory, meaning, and language. They also play a role in emotion and learning. The temporal lobes are concerned with interpreting and processing auditory stimuli.
Occipital Lobe	Location	Characteristics
	The occipital lobe is found in	The occipital lobe is involved with the brain's ability to
