their target ...




VIII is the story of Hal, a boy of extraordinary talents. Astonishing warrior skills. Sharp intelligence. And a fierce sense of honour and virtue.

Haunted by the ghosts of his family's violent past, Hal embarks on a journey that leads him to absolute power, and brings him face to face with his demons.




Kyla's memory has been erased,




34 kids missing. Vanished without a trace.

# A MONSTER CALLS



been expecting.


He's been expecting the one from his
