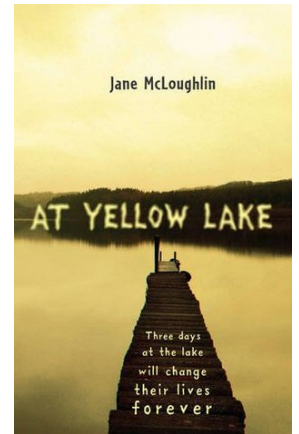


AT YELLOW LAKE
